To apply for a scholarship, applicants must submit this form, a program application, and a copy of the applicant's most recent 1040 tax return (copies of tax returns for parents/guardians are also required for students who are considered dependents).

Scholarship funds are limited and are awarded on a first come, first served basis. Please apply as soon as possible. Applications are reviewed within two weeks of receipt. When a decision has been made, a notification letter will be mailed from our office.
